The Tryon Palace was originally built between 1767 and 1770 as the first permanent capitol of the Colony of North Carolina and home to the Royal Governor and his family. It was soon regarded to be the finest public building in the American colonies. The restored Palace was opened to the public in 1959 as North Carolina's first great public history project. Both floors of the palace are open to visitors and guides in period costume conduct the tours. Grab your family and friends and join in on the fun for this relaxing and educational trip back in time.
