Mayor Bloszinsky called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. stating the purpose of this Legislative Hearing is to receive public comments on the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

The proposed budget includes the following highlights:

- 1) No proposed property tax rate increase
- 2) No changes to the water and sewer rate structure
- 3) No increase in monthly Storm Water fees
- 4) Addition of one full-time employee in the Public Works Department
- 5) An increase of \$1.16 (14.6%) to the monthly recycle fee
