## CALL TO ORDER

The Kure Beach Town Council held a special meeting on May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 for the purpose of receiving the proposed fiscal year 2008-2009 budget.

Mayor Montgomery called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

# PRESENTATION OF BUDGET

Town Administrator James stated the proposed budget:

- Has a total operating budget of \$4,787,435, which is an increase of five percent over the current operating budget.
- Includes grants and projects estimated at \$2,282,900.
- Has a combined total of \$7,069,335.
- Tax Levy is .135.
- Tax Base is \$1.2 billion
- Has an estimated value of \$117,000 per each one cent increase to taxes
- Includes hiring a new police officer in January 2009, adding four lifeguard positions and two lifeguard stations and grant funding to eliminate 12 storm water beach outfalls.
- Provides for a weekly residential recycling program with no increase in cost to residents— cost to be absorbed by removing the recycling container at Joe Eakes Park.
- Includes a \$1.2 million water rehab project with grant funding of \$591,000 and Town contribution of \$609,000 to be financed locally.

- Minimizes draws to balance the budget from reserve accounts.
- May require a mid-year or 12 month rate increase to cover inflation and rising fuel costs.
- There is a need to have a three year plan to determine 'magical' figure to retire debt, pay for capital projects and preparation for natural disaster.
- Projects Tourism Development Authority (TDA) funds at \$114,000 plus \$55,000 from this year's budget for a total of \$169,000.
- Proposes the lifeguard program to be funded by TDA dollars.
- Continues dental and vision insurance coverage for employees through the North Carolina League of Municipalities.
- Contracts for medical insurance through the State Health Plan.
- Funds 50 percent of the premium plan chosen by employees under the State Health Plan in an E-Z Flex Card.
- Includes funding to revitalize the B1 District.

# REVENUES - all funds

Town Administrator James gave an overview of general fund revenue projections stating:

- Ad valorem tax is budgeted at 98% with collection rate of taxes to date at 97%.
- There is no proposal for transfer of funds from water/serf expansion reserve fund to water fund
- Capital project figures are budgeted as a wash.

# EXPENDITURES - General Fund

Town Administrator James gave an overview of general fund line item expenditures as follows:

- Cost Of Living Adjustment (COLA) is budgeted at 3.3%.
- Employee merit is budgeted at 3% maximum for each employee. Merit range is 0 to 3%.

# Governing Body

- FICA the former formula was incorrect so amounts shown are less than budgeted in the past.
- Dues and subscription memberships includes everything for the Town except anything for a particular department.

 Advertising budget for all Town advertising except Building Inspector CAMA advertising and Planning and Zoning advertising.
