House Bill 1384 relative to height limitation of structures in the Town of Calabash House Bill 1469 relative to height limitations of structures in the Town of Yaupon Beach Informational work sheets received at the Essentials of Government Session

General discussion and comments were made relative to the various methods of way to insure the height limit does not exceed the present 35 foot height limit, i.e., making it a part of the Town Charter which no one felt was needed. Also to adopt a resolution requesting the legislation require a referendum of the registered voters....a petition from X % of the registered voters requesting Council......would this height restriction be throughout all areas of the Town or specific areas—who pays for special elections.
