KURE BEACH BEAUTIFICATION MEETING OCTOBER 9, 2006

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 PM at the Town Hall with the following in attendance:

The Committee has the funding to purchase additional trees and to plant them. The target date for the planting is November 11^{th} .

The Dog Park committee would like to plant 3 trees by the park, they will pay for them, plant them and care for them.

Bud Nelms, a resident of 6^{th} Street, would like to plant palm trees. The Committee plans to plant Oak Trees on 6^{th} Street.

A motion was made, seconded and approved for three Oaks at the Dog Park providing they pay for them, plant them and care for them. A second motion was made, seconded and approved for the Palm trees on 6th Street, provided Mr. Nelms pays for them, plants them where the committee approves, and cares for them. Also they must be palms that are native to Kure Beach.

Barry Nelder and Dean Lamberth will solve the watering problem on 6th Street.

Joe Hearns has given the town the proper documents to transfer a ¾ acre lot to the town for a Green Space. The Committee will discuss this further as to what should be planted, etc. A watering system is already installed. A survey of the property will be needed.
