REVISED MISSION STATEMENT:

- 1. To initiate, promote and assist in the implementation of programs of general community beatification in Kure Beach.
- 2. To provide leadership and guidance in matters of area or community design and appearance to the Town of Kure Beach.
- 3. To formulate and recommend to the governing body the adoption of amendments of ordinance (including the zoning and other local ordinances regulating the use of property) that will, in the opinion of the Committee, serve to enhance the appearance of the municipality and its surrounding areas.
- 4. To direct the attention of Kure Beach officials to needed enforcement of any ordinances that may in any way affect the appearance of Kure Beach.
- 5. To promote public interest in and an understanding of its recommendations, studies and plans, and to that end to prepare, publish and dstribute studies and reports as will, in the opinion of the Committee advance the cause of improved municipal appearance.
- 6. To request public input of beautification ideas and thoughts for Kure Beach
