- C. Atlantic Ave. After the heavy rain, several plants acquired a fungus, RTM replaced them with plants that are resistant to fungi's.
- D. Town Entrance Signs. The committee would like to change the Welcome to Kure Beach signs to make them all the same.
- E. Need someone to maintain the planted areas. Tony proposed the following: "Ken is to relay to The Council that Public Work's could not get a volunteer to be trained for landscape maintenance, therefore Beautification wants Council to decide whether or not it is feasible to hire a trained landscaper to deal with maintenance."

The committee suggests using TDA funds for maintenance of the various plantings in the town, such as the entrance signs, the Town Hall, etc.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. We still need an additional member plus at least one alternate member.
- 2. 5 Year Plan. Ken asked the committee to bring their ideas for the future to the next meeting in May.
