- 2. Renovate the welcome sign on Dow Road, coordinating it with the new design on 421 & Alabama Ave.
- 3. Add a welcome sign at the south end of 421 by the Riggings. DOT approval will be necessary. Ken Withrow will find out what signs Mr. Beeker already has in the Public Works storage building that are available to be renovated.
- 4. The ongoing issues with maintenance of town landscaping should be addressed. It is time to weed, mulch, and prune. Has Council identified volunteers and interns to help with these tasks?
