

KURE BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER
SEPTEMBER 13, 2011 MINUTES

The September 13, 2011, meeting of the Kure Beach Community Center Committee was called to order at 10:00 a.m. Members present were Irene Barber, Pam Bramhall, Donna Budd, Mararuth Capell, Lore Eccleston, Nancy Hughes, Jeanne Martin, Charlotte Philemon, and Chuck Keener, Town Council Representative and Mayor Dean Lambeth. Jean Martin began the meeting with an opening prayer. August 9, 2011 minutes were approved with a correction regarding the September date of the social dance with Tony and Diane, which should read September 17, 2011,

Jeanne gave the treasurer's report bringing committee members up-to-date with her usual outstanding financial report regarding the financial status of the Community Center.

OLD BUSINESS

Annual Barbeque

Discussion ensued regarding the outcome and success of the annual barbeque. Jeanne reported that 191 tickets were sold and the net proceeds were \$813.62. It was noted that the number of tickets and the net proceeds have been down for the past two years. Since there was a lot of food left over, the Committee also will need to review the amount to order for next year if we continue to have the barbeque.

Mayor Lambeth recommended that left over food from future events be taken to Shelters and Help Centers. Mararuth reported that she took the leftover rolls to the Good Shepherd House, the desserts will be put out at the community center dances, and there are plans that the leftover barbeque will be offered to Kure Beach Public Works employees for lunch.

NEW BUSINESS

Frances Regan, Community Center Chair for more than 18 years, submitted her resignation in August. Discussion ensued regarding plans to recognize her, which, at this time, will remain among committee members and the Town Council. Final plans and decisions will be reported at a later time. We are all grateful to Frances for all of her years of outstanding volunteer service to the Community Center and the Town of Kure Beach. She has the admiration, love, and affection of her Committee members and the Town of Kure Beach for her many years of guidance and devotion to the Community Center and she will be greatly missed.

Discussion ensued regarding the annual election of officers, and the current officers will remain the same. Jean Martin remains as Co-Chair, Jeanne Gordon as Treasurer, Donna Budd as recording Secretary, and other committee members' positions remain the same. A Committee Chair has not yet been selected.

Chuck continued the discussion and answered questions regarding future plans for New Hanover County Parks and Recreation Department, using UNCW interns, to eventually take over the scheduling of the Town's Community Center, Parks and Recreation, Disc Golf Course, and the new Oceanside Park's classes and events.

NOTE: At the Kure Beach Quarterly Committee meeting that Donna attended on September 15, 2011, Mayor Lambeth proposed that a meeting be scheduled with the County Parks and Recreation representative, Kure Beach Parks and Recreation Committee, and the Kure Beach Community Center Committee to discuss the plans to establish and implement the intern program.
