MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 13, 2015

Old Business

Nikki updated the committee on rentals. Due to the recent storms some rental was lost. One new HOA meeting was scheduled.

The community center will hold a hospice information session on October 14. On October 21 at 6:30 a political forum for the candidates will be held.

Town News

Due to the recent storms, two water systems had some trouble. One problem was at the lift station and the other problems were from the manhole covers. Both are being addressed.

Beach renourishment begins in November. The work is based upon the dune profile determined by the Corp of Engineers.

No updates for the community center building were available.

Fall Program

Information on the Hospice program was sent via email to several groups, notices were placed in the Island Gazette, and information was posted on the marquee outside the building. It was decided to provide coffee and cookies for the program.

CPR classes will be held in January.

The committee decided to hold an easy Make and Take event on November 30. The project is to make a lighted outdoor sphere using chicken wire. Sign up for the program is by November 18. Advertising will begin on November 10.

Barbeque

A final wrap up for the barbeque expenses has not yet been finalized. It appears that the right amount of food and supplies were purchased.

Suggestions for the 2016 barbeque are as follows:

- Bake the beans in the oven rather than cook on the stove.
- Need to have more unsweetened tea with no lemon.
- Purchase “to go” cups or get tops for the cups on hand.
- Purchase seven gallons of lemonade.
- Plan to have live music, possibly South of K.
- Restrict use of the parking lot next to the Community Center to reserve for barbeque patrons.
- Explore the possibility of having a charity to sell beer to go with the barbeques.
