By motion made, seconded and carried the minutes from the September meeting was adopted. By motion made, seconded and carried the agenda for the November 4th meeting was adopted.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. The committee accepted the resignation from Linda Cheshire
- 2. The committee named Priscilla Smith as presiding secretary
- 3. By motion made, seconded and carried the Committee changed the member count from nine (9) to seven (7) plus one (1) alternate
- 4. The committee received a application for appointment to SLAP committee from Dick Graham. By motion made, seconded and carried Dick Graham was welcomed to the SLAP committee.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Solar lighting at Beach Accesses. This project is presently on hold. The committee needs Michelle's information about obtaining a grant for this project.
- 2. Existing boardwalk. The plan is to have every other bench removed, lower the railing for ADA accessibility install all new boards. Possibly removing the benches in front of the Ocean Park was discussed. The projected cost is around \$30,000. At present there are no funds available for this project.
- 3. Ocean Park Restroom. The committee is still waiting for the RFI from the Ocean Park committee. Mayor elect Lambeth advised the committee that there is a company who would build the restroom, deliver it and install it.
- 4. Additional member needed. The committee welcomed Dick Graham and lost Linda Cheshire as members. We still need one (1) member and (1) alternate.
- 5. Beach Crossovers. We are still waiting for Sawyer to come up with the plans. When they are received they will be given to Snow to put the ADA stands on the four walkways and the emergency entrance. Chuck Keener will contact Sawyer and ask

him to make the end one foot wider so wheel chair users can turn around to exit the walkway.

- 6. Parking areas in town. The MPO Presentation will be on 11/17/09 at 6:30pm at the town hall
- 7. LED sign. This was presented to Council at the October meeting and is on hold until the new Council is seated. The estimated cost for three signs that would be used at each of the town's entrances, Alabama Ave and K Ave is \$36,000. P & Z has an ordinance regarding LED signs in town. The committee was asked to research how many towns have LED signs.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:10PM. The next scheduled meeting will be on December 1st at 5:00 PM at the Town Hall.
