NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Priscilla Smith named as presiding secretary.
- 2. Linda Chesire approved as alternate at prior Town Council meeting
- 3. Dick Graham approved for regular SLAP member by Town Council
- 4. Discussion on overlay committee. Dick Graham has joined this committee as our representative. P&Z is also part of this committee.
- 5. Formulate a new list of new and remaining projects for 2010:
 - a. The committee recommends implementing the changes listed in the MPO Report. Dick Graham will create a power point on all items.
 - b. Bathroom at Eakes Park, E, I, and the Ocean Park
 - c. Sidewalks on Ave K.
 - d. Pedestrian cross walks at 17 beach access locations.
 - e. Map for parking locations
 - f. Solar lighting at beach access locations. This could be a green grant.
 - g. Extend walkways past the Dunes at all public accesses.
 - h. Repair old Boardwalk and make it more ADA accessible.
 - i. Look into purchasing pre-fab bathrooms.
 - j. Make N Ave a one way and create additional parkilng
 - k. Pave the parking areas on I and E.
 - l. Recommend no speed bumps on Atlantic Avenue.
 - m. Obtain flag poles and flags to be place in front of the Police Station and the Fire House.

- n. Check with Bill McDow on what is the next step to obtain a pedestrian button for the traffic light on K Ave. Who at DOT should we contact.
- o. Continue research regarding LED signs for the Town.
- p. Create two additional handicap spaces. One by the Pier and the other by Big Daddy's.
- q. Parking locations on Ft. Fisher need lines to show where the parking is.
- r. The parking at Eakes Park need to be defined. There is 50 possible spaces.
- s. Parking at the Corral needs street access and signage.
- t. Install a sidewalk up to the Fire Dept. and along K Ave.
- *u.* Lighting on E, I. and 6th for parking.
