

STORM WATER COMMITTEE MEETING
October 10, 2008
Minutes

The Kure Beach Storm Water Committee met at Town Hall on October 10, 2008

The following were discussed or acted upon.

1. Michelle indicated she would follow up on status of grant for Dog Waste Stations.
2. After some discussion a motion was made and passed to request the Request for Proposal for the Oceanfront Park include a desire to incorporate as many different storm water BMPs as practical (such as rain barrel, cistern, pervious pavers, pervious pavement, bio retention area and underground infiltration system (may use new dune system); so that this can be a demonstration area for all who visit park. Motion was passed unanimously.
3. Eric gave review of new storm water rules which lowered the commercial threshold from one acre to 10,000 sq ft and tightened up the amount of built upon area near SA waters. Even though the SA waters restrictions are more stringent than those in Kure Beach's ordinance, the fact that we are covered under the Universal Storm Water Ordinance; we will not need to alter our ordinance. All other municipalities in the 20 coastal counties will have to modify their ordinances when they come up for renewal.
4. Was brought up that our next meeting was scheduled for Veteran's Day. Eric indicated he would arrange to change the date.
5. Motion was made and passed to adjourn meeting.
