She will add bike and pedestrian safety information.</p> <p><b>Update on Intersections and Master Plan:</b> AO reported progress is being made and more information will come after the next NCDOT meeting.</p> <p><b>KB Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan:</b> Adopted by Town Council and SG reported that it will now go to WMPO board. Mo asked SG if committee could get a poster of the master plan.</p> <p><b>Crosswalk Signage:</b> AO is working to get estimates—approximately \$6,795 per crossing (push button activated) and town is working with Representative Charlie Miller to seek funding for that and other town projects.</p> <p><b>Spot Lane Connector:</b> AO reported there are issues with the paving company that is why it hasn't been paved to date.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Signage:</b> ML reported they should be like the CB Greenway signs and include a kiosk that shows a map of bike routes through town, as well as a bench.</li> </ul>
