- A Greenway would be nice to make connections but it should NOT be in wetlands behind peoples homes, Greenway in Carolina beach was done very differently. A better route is along Dow Rd. If the intent is to connect the state park and bicyclists from other side of bridge then the best and easiest route is to stay along Dow Rd to K Ave.

Alternatively, some streets can be used, just like they are north of Carolina beach park. They will also have to be used in south Kure beach near the Air force Rec center.

But there are serious wetland issues and some flooding behind Seltzer's Ln homes and I believe a path there would be a mistake for the environment as well as potential unfriendly encounter behind people's homes. Thank You
