

**Dogs are allowed on the beach 5 pm until 9 am
April 1st - Sept 30th**



Dogs allowed anytime on beach Oct 1st - Mar 31st

- All dog owners are to **CLEAN UP** their pet's waste. A "means of disposal" must be carried by any person with a dog.
- All dogs are required to be on a **leash or restraint** with lead line not to exceed 15' in length.

Fines are enforced

Did you Know Sea Turtles are protected and endangered species?

Nesting and Hatching Season is from May 1st though October 31st.

Nests are very fragile. Do not disturb!

Keep your Ocean Front **LIGHTS OFF** during Nesting and Hatching Season.

NO flashlights if you see a nesting turtle or hatchlings

KURE BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS – FINES UP TO \$250 ARE ENFORCED

- **Alcohol is Prohibited** on the beach strand at all time and in public elsewhere throughout the town.
- **Trespassing on the sand dunes** is prohibited. Generally, any area with sea oats or grass growing is a protected sand dune.
- **Littering** including cigarette butts is prohibited. Trash receptacles are located at all public access points. **No glass** containers allowed on beach .
- **Fireworks** are **prohibited** on the beach at all times.
- **Fires and Grills** are **prohibited** on the beach at all times.
- **Beach Equipment** (chairs, tents, volleyball nets, cabanas, fishing gear etc.) is not allowed to be left on the beach strand between the hours of **7PM and 8AM. It will be removed and disposed of.**
- No Tents, Chairs or other beach equipment is allowed within 15' of the dune line. This area is reserved for **emergency vehicle access.**
- **Digging ANY size hole** on the beach is dangerous. Holes may not exceed 5' wide X 16" deep. Holes must be attended by a responsible adult and filled in before leaving the beach, no later than 30 minutes prior to sunset
- **Motor driven vehicles** on the beach are Prohibited
- **Swimming** within 100 feet or **Surfing** within 250 feet of the fishing pier is prohibited. Dangerous conditions always exist.

POLICE OFFICERS PATROL THE BEACH STRAND DAILY. FINES ARE ENFORCED.
