These lighted chicken wire globes are easy to construct and make a great addition to any holiday display. If you are going to participate, you will need to bring gloves and string lights (at least 200 lights per globe is recommended). Chicken wire will be provided and an instructional video will be available for viewing.



Kid's Crafting Table:

There will be all things holiday cheer at this crafting table for the kids to create their own decorations!

Cookie Exchange:

Bring already made, ready to share, samples of your favorite holiday cookie(s)! We recommend 3-6 cookies per package bagged/wrapped and ready to share. Bring as many packages to share as you hope to bring home so that we can all enjoy a wide assortment of our neighbors' favorite traditions. Although not required, a recipe to accompany the cookies would be an added bonus!
