

KURE BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER  
MEETING MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 10, 2015

The November meeting of the Kure Beach Community Center committee came to order at 10:00 a.m.

Members present were Harriet Owsley, Barbara Boal, Jeannie Gordon, Kathleen Zielinski, Robin Sack, Mararuth Cabell and Mandy Barton, Nikki Keely and Craig Bloszinsky from the town. Elaine Hall attended as a prospective new member.

The minutes from October were approved.

**Old Business**

There were no new rentals to report. A HOA meeting is scheduled for December. There were a few recent inquires and a couple of joint rentals for spring.

The Holiday Market is set for November 21st and the 28<sup>th</sup> from 9-3. There will be craft vendors as well as food trucks. A Christmas theme photo booth will be at the Holiday Market as well.

The Christmas show will be held the second weekend in December. The newly elected Kure Beach mayor, Emilie Swearingen, will ride in the parade on a golf cart. In the past there was a train and a suggestion was made that if it is still available perhaps the train could be used in next year's parade.

**Town News**

On November 2 Kure Beach elected a new mayor. Residences will soon see the dredgers that will put sand back on the beach.

**Building Update**

Many of the replacements have been completed. This includes tiles and a window. A new window and light switch were installed.

The newest project of the art viewing shelves will take place after the repair budget is final. The committee voted to remove the AV storage cupboard. It was also reported that the soap/towel dispenser in the men's room was not working.

**Fall Program**

The Hospice fall program was not well attended by the community. Several community center members did sign up to volunteer with Hospice.

The Christmas Sphere community craft project has eighteen people signed up to participate. Robin reported that Lowe's has the best price for 2'x50' for galvanized wire. The project will be held on November 30 at 6:30. Members are asked to be at the center by 5:30.

It was decided that the CPR certification class would be held either February 6<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> from 9-12.

### **Officers 2016**

Harriet encouraged the committee to think of choosing a new chairperson. Elections will take place at the January meeting.

### **Budget**

It was suggested that the committee invest in a smart television to enhance rentals and meeting events. It needs to be mounted and secured to the wall.

Jeannie reviewed the barbeque report that showed a profit of 2,089.58. She also shared a spreadsheet of all petty cash expenses.

The overall income generated by the community center was 141% over the town budget. The unexpected maintenance and repairs took additional monies from the budget. A budget amendment was requested to pay for this.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
