TOWN OF KURE BEACH STORMWATER COMMITTEE

The Kure Beach Stormwater Committee held its regular meeting on Monday, June 26, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. Chair, Tracy Mitchell called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and a quorum of members was present.

MINUTES: Minutes dated March 27, 2023, were APPROVED as submitted.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

Continued review of HOA Stormwater Permit Maps. Discussed HOA requirements to keep maintenance books updated with the town. We discussed the financial responsibility of repairs for HOAs and costs on private property and the repairs on public property to be paid by the town.

TOKB UPDATES

Town has approved the town budget effective July 1, 2023. Council to decide on contractor piece for behind Settlers Lane for drainage in the Fall. Working to get the contract for stormwater. We will have a contractor looking at water flows on the sections that we didn't do three years ago to complete that (portions north and south of town). The council will most likely act in September/October timeframe.

Jimmy is waiting for money to be awarded for a grant to basically id our water and sewer systems in it and according to how big the grant is, it can be stormwater systems as well where they will go and GIS everything that we don't have and make sure we have 100% list of all of the water and sewer and potentially stormwater systems according to when the grant comes back.

We still have not heard back from the State on our application of two years ago to use our revised plan from your audit and as soon as we hear that we will be working on revising our entire stormwater ordinance and this committee will be involved in that. Calls have been made to the State saying it's been pretty long asking for a decision or feedback. We are doing what we need to do as far as the information on the HOA audits and maintenance so if we get audited again, we have the HOA's licenses within our jurisdiction. The town has the maintenance records for each of the HOA stormwater ponds.

UPDATES FROM PUBLIC WORKS

Mississippi Avenue. North end of town, COMPLETE. Pinfish jobs completed over 300 feet and six new catch basins, and we are working on Sloop Point and Sailor replacing old stormwater pipes and should be complete by the end of this week.
