Official notice of this Legislative Hearing was posted on the Town's website and bulletin board on May 20, 2025 and was advertised in the Pleasure Island News on May 22, 2025 and May 29, 2025, thus meeting notification requirements.

The proposed budget includes the following highlights:

- 1. No changes in services provided or level of services provided
- 2. Proposed property tax rate of 17.2 cents per \$100 of valuation (Revenue neutral tax rate)
- 3. No significant increases in General Fund fees
- 4. Proposed 5% increase to the water and sewer minimum charge and the usage-based rate tiers
- 5. Proposed 25% increase to monthly Storm Water fees
- 6. Employee Compensation
 - COLA: 2.5%
 - Merit: 2%
