CALL TO ORDER

David Heglar called the meeting to order at 6:04 PM.

SELECTION OF CHAIRPERSON

David Heglar inquired whether any of the participants were interested in the chairperson position. The primary responsibilities of the chairperson are attending the council meeting, overseeing the Stormwater Committee meetings, and general governance. Bob Cooil volunteered to assume the chairperson role, which was seconded by Paul Markson and approved unanimously by those in attendance.

DETERMINE THE PROCESS WE WILL USE TO REVIEW THE FINAL KURE BEACH STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN (SWMP)

The Town Council adopted the Universal Storm Water Ordinance for Kure Beach, effective September 1, 2007. The Stormwater Ordinance (September 1, 2007) that the committee will review and recommend changes to conform to the SWMP is attached at:

We have until July to finish the review. The first step is to perform an initial artificial intelligence (AI) assessment to identify omissions, as well as potential eliminations, or edits. David will request that the town staff initiate an AI review of the documents. In parallel, the committee members will review the Ordinance and the Kure Beach SWMP and highlight any inconsistencies. David will also investigate whether there are any updated recommendations from the DEQ for stormwater ordinances.
