CALL TO ORDER

Bob Cooil called the meeting to order at 6:06 PM.

REVIEW OF COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE KURE BEACH STORM WATER ORDINANCE

David Heglar presented the committee members' recommendations and comments for the Kure Beach Storm Water Ordinance.

A question for the town attorney is whether the ordinance should include links to the applicable statutes/laws and fee structure. An additional question for the town attorney pertained to how the NCDEQ defines a storm discharge rate. David Heglar will follow up with the town attorney on these questions.

Michael Davenport added 'boilerplate' legal language to the document and recommended including the full name and the corresponding abbreviation the first time the word or phrase is referenced in the document.

During this meeting, all recommendations and comments through page 23 of the 38-page document were reviewed. The plan is to review the balance of the ordinance at the next meeting.
