RESOLUTION R24-02

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PARTICIPATION GOAL FOR HISTORICALLY UNDERUTILIZED BUSINESSES IN CERTAIN BUILDING PROJECTS

WHEREAS N.C.G.S. § 143-128.2 (hereinafter, the "Statute") requires North Carolina municipalities to undertake certain actions to increase participation by historically underutilized businesses ("HUB"), as that term is defined under N.C.G.S. § 143-128.4, in certain building projects;

WHEREAS the Statute requires a verifiable 10% goal for HUB participation in building projects costing \$100,000 or more and for which the municipality received State grant funds;

WHEREAS the participation goal will be verified based upon the documentation submitted by contractors in their bid proposals which demonstrates their good faith efforts to increase HUB participation;

WHEREAS the Town's current Public Works Building Project (hereinafter, the "Project") will cost more than \$100,000 for which the Town has received State grant funds; and

WHEREAS Council has noticed and held a public hearing on the question of establishing a HUB participation goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Council in a meeting duly noticed and assembled, that:

- 1. A verifiable 10% goal of HUB participation in the Project is hereby established.
- 2. Staff is instructed to implement, per sub-section (e) of the Statute and prior to soliciting bids for the Project, a good faith outreach program making it feasible for HUB entities to submit responsive bids for the Project.
